NOTICE OF RACE



RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Charlottetown Race Week regatta is open to all keelboat classes. Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online registration on the Charlottetown Yacht Club web site and signing the Prince Edward Island Sailing Association Code of Conduct. All boats must hold a valid PHRF rating certificate. Boats without a valid PHRF rating certificate must make arrangements with the Authority for measurement prior to July 16th.

FLEETS

4 or more boats of the same class registered by 09:00 hours on Thursday July 16th will constitute a fleet. All other boats will sail in their respective PHRF fleets. The fleet names and their rating ranges will be posted on the official notice board. It is expected that there will be Premier, "A", "B", J-24, J-29 and White Sail fleets.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon completion of registration at the Charlottetown Yacht Club.

VENUE

The Charlottetown Yacht Club is located at 1 Pownal St Charlottetown, PEI.

COURSES

There are four possible course configurations:

1. Windward/Leeward. Depending on the conditions the course(s) may be inside or outside the harbour.
2. Windward/Leeward. Start in Hillsboro bay and finish at the Yacht Club.
3. There may be, depending on the conditions, a Friday night long distance race for the Premier fleet.
4. Start in the harbour, race to a pre-determined buoy and possible finish at the Yacht Club.

AMENDMENTS

Any amendments to this Notice of Race will be posted here no later than June 16th, 2009.

SCORING

Eight races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency or communication by the Race Committee, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

PRIZES

1st, 2nd and 3rd	Daily for each fleet and presented at the end of each day
1st, 2nd and 3rd	Overall for each fleet and presented at the end the regatta
Overall regatta winner	Presented at the end the regatta

INSURANCE

Each participant is responsible to ensure that he/she is covered by valid liability insurance.

RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in the event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES

I, _____, on behalf of my self, and crew, understand while competing, training and participating in this regatta, and events I/we must:

- Regard the Racing Rules as a form of agreement. The Rules represent the spirit which I/we shall not evade or break.
- Respect fellow sailors, volunteers and race officials.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat, be co-operative, sportsmanlike and always remain a team player.
- Treat the host club, public areas/docks, accommodation facilities, as well as other people's property as my own. I/we understand any willful destruction of property or theft is not permitted. Full payment will be required for any destruction.
- Not get involved in any act considered to be an offense under federal, provincial or local laws.

I/we understand if any disciplinary problems arise shall be investigated by the Regatta Jury, and Regatta Race Committee on site. If it is decided individuals are not adhering to the above guidelines, the following actions may be pursued;

- a) Termination of individual's participation in this regatta and events.
- b) Removal of individual's right to compete in future related events.
